Physiological basis

Intracellular enzyme involved in amino acid metabolism. Present in large concentrations in liver, kidney; in smaller amounts, in skeletal muscle and heart. Released with tissue damage, particularly liver injury.

Interpretation

Increased in: Acute viral hepatitis (ALT > AST), biliary tract obstruction (cholangitis, choledocholithiasis), alcoholic hepatitis and cirrhosis (AST > ALT), liver abscess, metastatic or primary liver cancer; nonalcoholic steatohepatitis; right heart failure, ischemia or hypoxia, injury to liver ("shock liver"), extensive trauma; drugs that cause cholestasis or hepatotoxicity. **Decreased in**: Pyridoxine (vitamin B6) deficiency.

Comments

ALT is the preferred enzyme for evaluation of liver injury.
