APS is diagnosed if at least one laboratory criterion and one clinical criterion are met. For the laboratory criteria, they need to be observed on two or more separate occasions, with each test done at least 12 weeks apart.

Comments

A phospholipid antibody test measures the levels of autoantibodies against cardiolipin, phosphatidylserine, phosphatidylinositol, and phosphatidic acid. It helps diagnose an increased risk of blood clots in patients with systemic lupus erythematosus (20-35% of cases) and other similar disorders. This test is also used to diagnose Antiphospholipid syndrome (APS) in patients with recent miscarriage (11-22% in all trimesters), Pulmonary hypertension, Non-vegetative endocarditis, Livedo Reticularis, Stroke at young age and Deep vein thrombosis.
