Physiological Basis

HBeAg is a soluble protein secreted by HBV, related to HBcAg, indicating viral replication and infectivity. Two distinct serologic types of hepatitis B have been described, one with a positive HbeAg, and the other with a negative HBeAg and a positive anti-HBe antibody.

Interpretation

Increased (positive) in: HBV (acute, chronic) hepatitis.

Comments

The assumption has been that loss of HBeAg and accumulation of HBeAb are associated with decreased infectivity. Testing has proved unreliable, and tests are not routinely needed as indicators of infectivity. All patients positive for HBeAg must be considered infectious.
